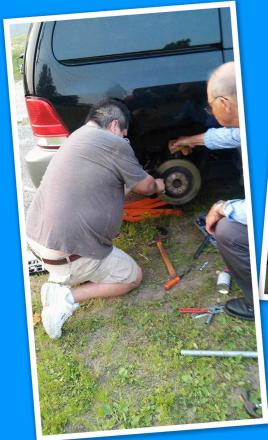
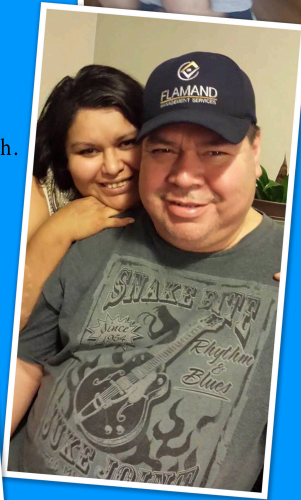
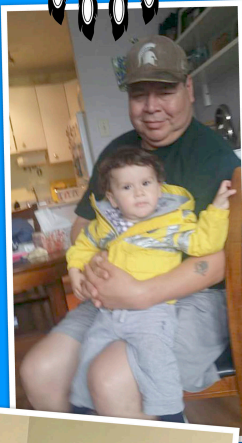


You gave no one a last farewell,
